Dr. Charles J. Marcuccilli Named Danny Did Foundation Medical Advisor
Milwaukee doctor joins Danny Did Foundation to prevent seizure-related deaths

CHICAGO – Aug.1, 2011 - The Danny Did Foundation has today announced the addition to its Medical Advisory Board of Dr. Charles J. Marcuccilli, PhD, MD. Dr. Marcuccilli, an Associate Professor in the Division of Pediatric Neurology at the Medical College of Wisconsin in Milwaukee, is the second member of the Danny Did Foundation's Medical Advisory Board.

“Dr. Marcuccilli is a physician of the highest caliber who is dedicated to excellence in research, teaching, and patient care,” said Danny Did Foundation Executive Director Tom Stanton. “He is a natural fit for the DDF, as well, in that he specializes in pediatric neurology. The Danny Did Foundation (DDF) was established in January 2010 by Mike and Mariann Stanton after the unexpected death of their four-year-old son Danny, who died of a seizure while sleeping. The DDF Medical Advisory Board is a select group of medical professionals with a specific interest in confronting and solving the riddle that is Sudden Unexplained Death in Epilepsy (SUDEP).

Dr. Marcuccilli joins current DDF Medical Advisory Board member Dr. Marvin Rossi of Chicago’s Rush University Epilepsy Center as a DDF medical representative. Members of the DDF Medical Advisory Board act as medical experts on behalf of the Danny Did Foundation who share its vision of openly addressing SUDEP and who believe in the goal of preventing deaths caused by seizures.

Dr. Marcuccilli attended medical school at the University of Chicago’s Pritzker School of Medicine and trained at the University of Chicago’s Children’s Hospital in the departments of Neurology and Pediatrics. In addition to being a teacher, a researcher, and a clinician, Dr. Marcuccilli is also a skilled lecturer who was listed in 2010 as one of the “Best Doctors in America.”

Danny Did Foundation co-founder Mike Stanton is ready to bring Dr. Marcuccilli’s expertise and enthusiasm to the DDF’s table. “Once we were introduced to Dr. Marcuccilli,” Stanton stated, “we knew we had a guy who would fit in with the Danny Did Foundation’s ethos of getting things done.
